WHO WE ARE: YIT is a performing arts school that encourages students to fully express themselves through their craft. Our instructors are educators and professionals that have a passion for teaching and the arts. Students can expect to be treated individually and with respect and to grow as young performers.

TIME COMMITMENT: This production is a fast paced musical put together in just 3 weeks. With the limited amount of rehearsals we expect all cast members to be at every rehearsal. We understand that families already have schedules planned out for the Holiday season so please communicate with Julie Nottingham if you have any questions about rehearsal dates. Any absences due to illness please communicate directly to Julie Nottingham.

\$375 Tuition

Fees cover the cost of rights & royalties, scripts, facility rentals, costumes/props/sets, production staff, and more. Students will also receive a show t-shirt.

Before you audition, please consider all of the following:

- **DATES:** Please double check family, school, and extra-curricular calendars against the rehearsal calendar in this packet. If you have a conflict with a performance, you should not audition. If you have a few rehearsal conflicts here and there, you can still audition, but please look ahead and note them all on the audition form.
- **LIMITED SPACE:** We only have room for 30 students in the cast. This will be determined on who registers first. All students who audition will be in the cast. Once students are registered for the production, they will be able to select their audition time. There is a \$100 non-refundable Registration and Production Fee for reserving your audition slot.

MUST BE REGISTERED TO AUDITION

- **TIME COMMITMENTS:** Producing a successful play is very rewarding, but it requires a lot of hard work and dedication. Before auditioning for the show, please make sure that you are aware of the large commitment involved in participating in this production.

Performers must attend all of their *scheduled* rehearsals, however, please note that **all students may not be needed for each rehearsal**. A student's individual rehearsal schedule will be based on the role that he or she is playing in the production.

Two unexcused absences from rehearsals will result in removal from the show.

■ **Excused Absences Include:** illness, family emergencies, anything a school would consider an excused absence, and any dates/times listed as conflicts on the Audition Form/Contract. This should be communicated to the directing staff as soon as an emergency absence is known.

■ **Unexcused Absences Include:** Any full rehearsals missed not due to illness, family emergencies, those communicated on the Audition Form/Contract; and anything that a school would consider an unexcused absence.

- **BEHAVIOR POLICY**
